Our goal for the homeschooler program is to structure classes that fit the needs of our students. We have designed 5 classes that we believe will fill the requirements needed for elementary and secondary students. Our idea is for our students to understand visual arts in relation to history and culture, as well as to enhance communication of experience and ideas. In addition to artistry we will teach students terminology and familiarize them with artists both past and present.

Classes are as follows:

Compliments to the Artist Students will draw their own design and paint half of it in the colors of their choice. The other half of the picture will be painted with their complimentary colors.

All About Me Students will create a three-dimensional collage that will be a representation of themselves.

Coil Creations Using clay, students will create coil pots. Upon completion the students will turn these pots into creatures, a lantern, or a planter.

A New Perspective Students will create a pastiche. They will choose a piece of artwork from a variety of well known artists. Then the students will create their own interpretation of this artwork using pastels, acrylics, or water colors.

Weave All About it Students will weave their own reed baskets. They will learn specific weaving techniques and terminology.

# Compliments to the Artist

Elementary/Secondary

**Description:** Students will draw their very own design. They will then mix the colors to add to the design they have chosen. Half of the drawing will be painted in the colors of the student's choice. The other half will be painted using complimentary colors.

- The students will demonstrate knowledge of primary colors, secondary colors, as well as complimentary colors.
