

# SUMMER ART CAMP ACTIVITIES

Many of you have been asking what type of projects we will be doing in The Summer Art Program. Since I know I will be having some kids from last year, kids doing multiple weeks and kids that have done some projects here in the past I had wanted to keep it open so I could make sure each child does new and exciting things with each week.

I also realize that parents want to know what the projects will entail, to make sure their children will be interested, so I have included a list of projects the children may do each day. These will vary for all the reasons I stated above. Also please keep in mind they may be doing more than one project a day or larger projects may carry over to a second day.

Kids will be asked to bring in something for a snack break, except for Friday, when we will be having a Pizza Party. Due to allergies, please nothing containing nuts.

## Day 1 Clay Time

<b>Coil Pots</b>	That will be turned into monsters
<b>Clay Animals</b>	Using the pinch pot technique
<b>Pocket Pals</b>	Animals or people with a pocket using the slab technique
<b>Fun with Molds</b>	Kids will learn to pour molds, just like all of our bisque pieces are done
<b>Aztec Tile</b>	Learn about the Aztec culture and carve into slab to make a low-relief tile.

## Day 2 Paper Fun

<b>Sketch Books</b>	Make paper, design cover, and put together to make a personal sketchbook
<b>Découpage</b>	Using Mod Podge to attached different patterned paper to glass vases or wooden boxes
<b>Paper Mache</b>	Paper Mache Masks
<b>Torn Paper</b>	Inspired by Picasso, children with learn about Cubism and make a self portrait from torn paper
<b>Beads</b>	Paper Mache beads to paint and use to make necklaces and or bracelets

### Day 3 Weaving

- Paper Weaving** Learn the properties of weaving with paper
- Straight Weaving** Learn to weave using a cardboard loom
- Dream Catchers** A fun weaving technique using knots
- Coil Weaving** Weave a small pot using the coil technique
- Basket Weaving** Weave a basket using either paper or reeds

### Day 4 Media Mix

- Jewelry** Children will make necklaces, bracelets, and earrings using seed beads, large beads, paper beads and other foundlings.
- Drawing** We have a few projects where kids learn how to use line to make pattern drawings
- Painting** Projects inspired by artists like Jackson Pollock and George Seurat. Children will learn about artists and make paintings inspired by them
- Wax Resist** Children will make an underwater scene using crayons and water color paint to make a batik
- Mosaics** Children will make either a mirror mosaic or a sun catcher using a wide variety of tesserae
- Printmaking** Children will learn the principles of printmaking using stamps, stencils and even their shoes.

### Day 5 Glazing, Catch up and Pizza Party

- 1st** Glaze their clay pieces they made on the first day
- 2nd** Finish any projects not completed during the week
- 3rd** Pizza Party
